Reddit is a social network where millions of people add news for the rest to debate and vote on published topics. It is a combination of a news website and a discussion forum. It is one of the most used, it is in position number 11, with more than 430 million users. Its success lies in its unique operation.

In **Reddit** you are the one who decides what content you want to see, it is a message board where members send links and the rest of the community has to give you positive or negative points. The articles with more points in favor will go up in the classification and this makes it reach more people, coming to occupy the front page of the platform those most valued news.

This ensures that the cover content has been reviewed, voted on and discussed by thousands of other editors. These are things that will make you feel that what you are reading is not a hoax and with the security that this gives, motivating you to delve a little deeper into those topics that are interesting to you.

One of the advantages is that it allows anonymity to be maintained at all times, to enter a part you only need an email and a username. It has its own categorization, in which each published link goes directly to a **subreddit** related to that topic. These are communities where people with common interests meet to talk about their favorite topics, without having to read about others that do not interest them. If there is one that you would like to be part of, you just have to subscribe, inside you will find other more specific secondary subdivisions for almost anything on the subject.

The profiles are usually anonymous, but **Reddit** will keep a record of all the activity you carry out on the platform. Now they are incorporating a new system in which a photograph, a biography and a personal page can be included. It is a system that not everyone liked, so the previous way continues.

It will not always be true that the publications made in any of the subreddit groups appear in the highest area, this is due to a time reduction algorithm, which facilitates the increase of the most recent publication, so there are news that in less than five minutes have already been forgotten by the community. However, you have the option to sort content based on the newest and most controversial score.

Each subreddit has its own rules, it is very important that you understand and comply with them before publishing, because from **Reddit** they are very strict with their rules and you can be banned or expelled if they understand that what you are doing is spam, for example.

A subreddit is not just a place to link, it is a thriving community unto itself with its own jargon and moderators. The comment system is possibly the most important and fun part of the site. The voting system is also used for comments, which makes the discussion more valuable.

In order to control order, they have created the **Karma** points. Each user has their own score, which measures the quality of comments and their contributions to the community. Depending on whether you have many negatives or positives, your Karma will increase or decrease. This does not mean that you have a punishment or a reward for it, it is only so that other members can see the type of users that you are.

Reddit is totally **free**, you find it available in **Google Play Store** and **App Store**, and it has a Premium version with

which you can get a series of benefits, such as removing advertising, having your own personalized avatar and even exclusive subreddit for these members . This option is not significant for the use of the platform, it only gives a series of advantages. You can also give this gold to others, regardless of the reason.

There are **AMAs**, Ask Me Anything, they are users who are asked and have to answer on any topic. There is a specific subreddit for this available to any of the members, making this format one of the most popular on the network.

As the community that it is, **Reddit** is the perfect way to connect with others around the world, and help each other.
