It is a shooting game created by a Vietnamese through which you have individual and group missions in which you must kill as many as you can in the shortest period of time possible

Counter-Strike Global Offensive is one of the most popular FPS shooters in the world. It is a game that invariably reigns in the ranking of the most popular games for years: in its collection it has more than 39 million players from all over the world. Regularly 10 million people play CS: GO.

There are two teams in the game: **terrorists and anti-terrorists**. The task of each of them is to eliminate the opposing team or perform a specific task. In the case of terrorists, it is the base of a bomb or hostage defense and, in the case of anti-terrorists, protection of the detonation zone by placing a bomb or rescuing hostages. The game has seven different modes, each with different characteristics.

CS: GO, in addition to the integrated matchmaking system, allows players to play on Valve's dedicated servers, it also has the ability to create and play on community servers with non-standard maps and game modes. Since its launch, CS: GO has been one of the most popular first-rate shooters in the field of electronic sports. The most important tournaments are the so-called "Majors", matches sponsored by the game's publisher, Valve. CS: GO competitions are also part of the Electronic Sports World Cup computer games world championship.

CS: GO of most social games is different because it does not have servers that we can freely choose. The game automatically assigns us the ideal server for us, taking into account the location and signal strength of the server itself.

Some **simple tricks** to improve on kickback. CSGO is growing in popularity every day by leaps and bounds and as such there are many new players on the scene. However, the problem with CSGO is that the FPS skills you learn in other games don't always translate as well into CS due to its complexity and steep learning curve. With that said, let's talk about some tips.

Tip number one is to practice, then keep practicing, and when you're done with that practice a bit more. Professional players have to play every day and every night to maintain their level of play and of course most people don't want to be professional CS players and they don't have time, they just want to be half decent in the game, But the rule applies. You don't have to sit there every night practicing, but as with anything, the more you play and practice, the better off you will be.

Tip number two is to watch other players, see how they move, how they shoot, or watch other players' broadcasts, or even watch professional tunas. Everyone learns to play Counter Strike at one point. Almost everything everyone has learned is from other people.

The placement of crosshair number three is really important when **downloading Counter Strike**. Let's say you are walking through the long dust2 towards the bomb site and have your sights pointed towards the ground or only in the middle of nowhere unless some killer beavers or ants invade us. That is not going to be of much help. Not only that, if an enemy raises his ugly head from the corner, you actually have to move your crosshair further to get to him and

that will reduce your aim and reaction time. If, for example, you already had your sights at head height and were aiming for a common standby position at a bomb site or towards a CT spawn, for example, you're already in a better place and with an advantage.

Learning the map also helps with this because you can start aiming your crosshairs towards the most common places where you expect enemies to be.

Tip number four is conscience and this will cover a few things. First use your radar to know where other players are, both anamies and teammates, and who has the bomb too, this also works to know what equipment you have at any time (All bombs and smoke or flashes can be really useful in one-on-one meetings one).
