



Review Minecraft Earth

Minecraft Earth is a new augmented reality game for mobile devices, allowing players to bring Minecraft into the real world. Just like in Pokemon Go, players can enjoy exciting adventures, build great things together with their friends, and then enter their life-size creations.

Most of us are familiar with **Minecraft**, the sandbox video game created by Swedish game developer Markus Persson and released by Mojang in 2011. He has been at the top of the charts for 8 years, a classic that never dies. In Minecraft players can build with a variety of different blocks in a world generated by 3D procedures, requiring creativity from the players.

Other activities in the game include exploration, resource gathering, crafting, and combat. Multiple game-changing game modes are available, including, but not limited to, a survival mode, in which players must acquire resources to build the world and maintain health, and a creative mode, where players have resources unlimited to build with.

The Java edition of the game allows players to modify the game with mods to create new game mechanics, elements, textures, and assets. There are no specific goals to meet, allowing players a great deal of freedom to choose how to play the game. The game is very joyful - you can just walk and break blocks, and then do new things with the blocks you have collected. And if you've ever wished for the real world to look like this too, let me tell you, it will soon be possible.

Minecraft Earth is the new Minnecraft mode, due for release in 2019. The mode is currently in closed beta and only a few countries have access to it. It was first announced on May 17, 2019 and will be available as a free game on Android and iOS smartphones. Microsoft intends to release the game gradually, similar to the mobile version of Fortnite. This will prevent unexpected drops, long queues in the game, and similar unpleasant experiences.

Like the original, Minecraft Earth will also focus on destroying and constructing structures, gathering resources, crafting, exploration, and combat. The big difference is that you do it all in the real world. Similar to Pokemon Go, players can build augmented reality structures in collaboration with other players, gather resources through the use of "tappables" on the game map, and access "Adventures" which can be a puzzle or a specific task, or a virtual location with hostile entities to defeat.

Adventures reward players with in-game currency. Collaborative building is done on "building plates," and players can share copies of their completed structures. Minecraft Earth takes physical objects like trees and lakes into account so there are fewer incidents and interferences with the AR simulation.

Minecraft earth is like Pokemon Go an augmented reality game. Augmented reality is a technology that allows us to superimpose virtual elements on our vision of reality with the help of a device such as a mobile phone or a tablet.

Minecraft earth is a real life game with everything you know about Minecraft at your fingertips. You can break and build anything and even when you play with someone else you can see what tool or block they are using. You can also place your characters in your own corner in or wherever it wants and it reacts to your movements in real life.

One of the most incredible things is also that you can move your constructions from small to real size, and be within the world, and within your own constructions as well as interact with everything around you.

Minecraft Earth as we have already mentioned is a game only for mobile devices which brings us the world of Minecraft to our universe. It all starts with you and your character, you can change your skin to whatever you want, you can see the outline of your real world, the houses and the streets around you but within a Minecraft environment. You can walk around your neighborhood collecting blocks and even mobs, they just grab on by tapping them and they are everywhere.

There are different variations of animals which have categories, there are some rarer than others, who knows what you might find. We can also discover chests full of random things.

Everything you collect goes directly to your inventory! Go ahead and **download Minecraft Earth** and play it!
