Doing sudokus is one of the most relaxing and fun activities, there are many fans who do this grid in record time. But it is not only entertainment, with this game we exercise our brain and keep it active while we are playing. With the appearance of mobile games and applications it was inevitable that one of the most played was not this numbers game.

With this application you will be able to do your favorite sudokus whenever and wherever you want, regardless of whether you are online or offline, thanks to a free application. **Download Sudoku free**, you find it available in the main virtual stores, Google Play Store and App Store, compatible with **Android** and **iOS**.

This is the mobile version of this classic puzzle. With it you will not only have hours and hours of entertainment, but you also have the most complete sudoku learning system.

To start using it, it is as simple as installing it on your mobile phone and starting to play, it is that easy, you will not need to create a personal account. On the first screen that will appear, you only have to select the level you want to start with: easy, medium or difficult, once you have chosen it you just have to start.

Each of the boards that will appear are customizable and easy to handle, if you find yourself stuck in one of them you will only have to press the Hint button, it will automatically highlight one of the squares, in this way you will learn new techniques that they will help to keep moving forward. These do not give you the answer without more, they tell you how you can overcome the obstacle and reach the solution. They change with each new screen and stand out for their fun animation. With this function you will end up knowing all the techniques to become a Sudoku master.

Its interface is consistent with the application, it is designed to be clear and minimalist, only to enter numbers, in this way to make it very easy for users to follow the game system. Its scoring system adapts to each of its players to compete with herself or with her friends, no matter what level of difficulty she is at.

Within each of its difficulty levels, these are divided into other sublevels that will make the games very balanced. Do not be afraid, in **Sudoku** you will always find the level that best suits you, and thus, little by little it will increase in difficulty. Plus, its puzzles are endless, so the fun will never end.

Its way of playing is very simple, choose the hole you want to fill in the grid and select the number that goes, you have to fill in all the squares from number 1 to 9, it can only be one number for each hole, without numbers are repeated and completed equally horizontally and vertically, without any duplicate number. It seems easy, but it is not, as you level up you will see how it becomes increasingly difficult to combine numbers, square, rows and columns, so you will have to think more and more about what the exact number can be. With Sudoku you can fill in and erase the annotations as many times as you want, it has the option to auto-fill if a number has gotten stuck and you can't find a solution even using the clues.

In the free **Sudoku** application you will find world leaderboards and friends, in this way you can see graphically what your progress is. You can play from any device and do it vertically or horizontally, whatever suits your comfort best.

Although it has great popularity in Japan, the reality is that its origins go back to the United States. Since 2005, this fun game is known worldwide and sweeps wherever it goes. There are always tricks that will help you pass a Sudoku level, especially if you are a beginner. For example, you can take a general look across the board, in this way you can initially discard some numbers. When this doesn't work, he uses logical analysis, in this way, focusing more on the grids and starting to place the most frequent numbers in them. You can make annotations to the side that will help you narrow down the possibilities. **Download Sudoku** and master this technique.
