



Review Tom Clancy's The Division 2

A new installment from the acclaimed Ubisoft studios. Tom Clancy's The Division 2 features a third-person shooter adventure with elements from RPG games. It has a novel online proposal, a wide repertoire of weapons and one of the most important map works in recent years

Tom Clancy's The Division 2 was one of the most anticipated games of 2019. The installment developed by Ubisoft Massive and distributed by the French Ubisoft was very well received and is one of the most successful titles in the universe of games and applications.

We are not surprised that Ubisoft brings us an event of this type since in its catalog of phenomena it has giants such as: Prince of Persia, Rayman, For Honor, Assassin's Creed, Watch Dogs and Far Cry.

Tom Clancy's The Division 2 can be **played** on PlayStation 4, Xbox One, or the product can be **downloaded** for computers.

Downloading Tom Clancy's The Division 2 will give us access to an exciting story in which in the capital of the United States, as in other cities, chaos prevailed after humanity was decimated after being sprayed by a deadly virus of the black pox. The situation triggers the appearance of factions that want to take over the metropolis with the aim of generating new and brutal orders. For this reason, the members of the Title Division were chosen, that is, elite agents who mixed daily with a multitude of gray citizens to escape from underground and face the threat in the face of crisis. Now they must save the city, for the power in which not only groups of ruthless madmen fight, but also well-organized private armies.

The production puts at our disposal a vast open world that covers almost all of Washington on a one-to-one scale (you can easily find distinctive locations such as the Capitol and the White House here). Before starting the fight, we create a hero whose combat potential increases as the adventure progresses. In exchange for eliminating opponents (we are talking about serial opponents, as well as much stronger bosses), carrying out tasks and performing various side activities, we gain experience points, and after collecting the appropriate number, we advance to the next level. It is a third person shooter game with elements of RPG proposals.

One of the **advantages of Tom Clancy's The Division 2** is that its gameplay is developed in an excellent way. The number of missions is correct and, although sometimes the task seems simple or repetitive, we will not have any problem in doing it again because the game experience is excellent. Even the level of difficulty of each task is adjusted correctly to the moment in which our character and weapons are found.

There are different game modes in **Tom Clancy's The Division 2**. We can enjoy the experience in "Campaign", "Cooperative", "PVP" and the "Dark Zones".

In Campaign we will enroll in the mission in which we will have to save Washington D.C.; in cooperative we will participate together with other users in the most complex tasks of the product and we will have to concentrate on strategy and collaboration; In PVP we will face off against other people and in the Dark Zones we will enter one of the three maps where anything can happen.

The Dark Zones is the most outstanding proposal to play with other people since it is very original and we do not know what can happen during that type of games. It depends a lot on whether the people we run into want to collaborate or not. If, on the other hand, you are the player who prefers confrontations against other traditional online, you can do so in the PVP section.

The Ubisoft title does a lot of work when it comes to weapons and enemies. The armament that we will use is wide,

varied and very solid in terms of its handling. As it improves, when our character levels up, it will allow advances in the control and use of rifles, pistols or snipers. On the other hand, the variety of enemies is a very high point in which the company presents us with various characters who will want to defeat us. Each creature with its particular mechanics.

Tom Clancy's The Division 2 is without a doubt one of the releases that you should add to your video game collection. It has one of the best map development jobs available, great gameplay, and a very good story.
